Scholarship Terms

If you were selected as a scholarship winner during the 2011 camping season, you cannot reapply for a scholarship in 2012. If you won a scholarship prior to 2011, you will be eligible to reapply for the 2012 season. This is to ensure that all students have a fair chance at receiving a scholarship and an opportunity to attend Ferrwood Music Camp.

1. Students are only allowed a one week scholarship per camping season.
2. **Parents of students who receive a scholarship must volunteer at least 5 hours of time at camp. Volunteer hours will be closely monitored. Failure to volunteer will revoke the scholarship and the student will be asked to leave camp.**
3. Students must demonstrate a financial need. Students who qualify for free and reduced lunch in school will qualify to apply for a scholarship.
4. Students must write two essays on why they feel they should be awarded the scholarship. The essay will be scored on a 100 point rubric as outlined below.
5. Ferrwood Music Camp staff or faculty members will read and judge the essays. The essays will be presented to the judges anonymously.
6. Scholarships will be awarded to the students with the most number of points on their essays and successful candidates will be notified by mid June.
7. Successful essays will become the property of the Greater Hazleton Philharmonic Society.
8. The decision of the judging musicians is final.
